**HISTORY** In 1982, a group of teachers, business leaders and community activists in Petaluma convened to develop funding solutions for area schools in response to major budget deficits throughout the California school system. The outcome was the creation of the Petaluma Educational Foundation, a privately funded, non-profit organization whose primary goal is to raise money in the community to benefit education. The Petaluma Educational Foundation is designated by the Internal Revenue Service as a tax-exempt, non-profit, charitable 501(c)(3) organization.

Today, we serve over 12,000 students annually at all 38 TK-12th grade public, private, and charter schools in our community.

**MISSION** PEF creates impactful educational opportunities for all students in our community. We fund programs that promote critical thinking, creativity, student well-being, and lifelong learning.

**FUNDING** A total of **\$7,950,708** in financial support has been awarded through our grant and scholarship programs since the Foundation was founded. PEF receives no public funding. PEF raises funds from individuals, corporations and foundations. In addition, PEF manages Alphabet Soup Thrift Stores with two locations in downtown Petaluma. All proceeds from Alphabet Soup benefit the mission of PEF.

#### PROGRAMS

**Grants for Schools** Since 1983, PEF has granted more than **\$3,898,639** to teachers, administrators and parents to fund projects not covered in the school budget. The purpose of our Grant Program is to reward innovative academic programs and foster excellence in education for all Petaluma area students. This current academic year, PEF awarded 30 grants supporting Social-Emotional Learning and Technology Access and Devices totaling **\$132,454**.

**Scholarships for High School Graduates** PEF is honored to manage 77 scholarship Programs for donors who provide the Foundation with clear criteria for selecting recipients. This year, we awarded **\$237,559** to seniors graduating from all Petaluma area high schools, bringing the total to **\$4,052,069** awarded since 1990.

**Managed Funds** PEF manages over **\$5,149,2144** (as of December 2020) in invested and endowed funds with clear directions as to how the funds will benefit the schools in Petaluma. We also manage component funds for school-related organizations and clubs.

With funding for our schools uncertain, the role PEF plays is more important than ever.
